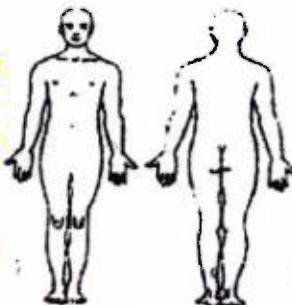

On December 23, 2011 at approximately 11:01 a.m. the Chadbourn Police Department received a call of a gunshot with trauma at 312 East 3rd Avenue. James [redacted] stated when he pulled his rifle out of the case to put it up on the wall the rifle went off. When officers responded they located the rifle on the floor, approximately four feet from the broken window. It appeared that one shot was fired through the closed window and it struck Jasmine [redacted] and Jahmesha [redacted] killing [redacted]. Fragments of the bullet struck Treka [redacted].

Three (3) of the K-2 cartridges were used as test fires and are being returned as such.


